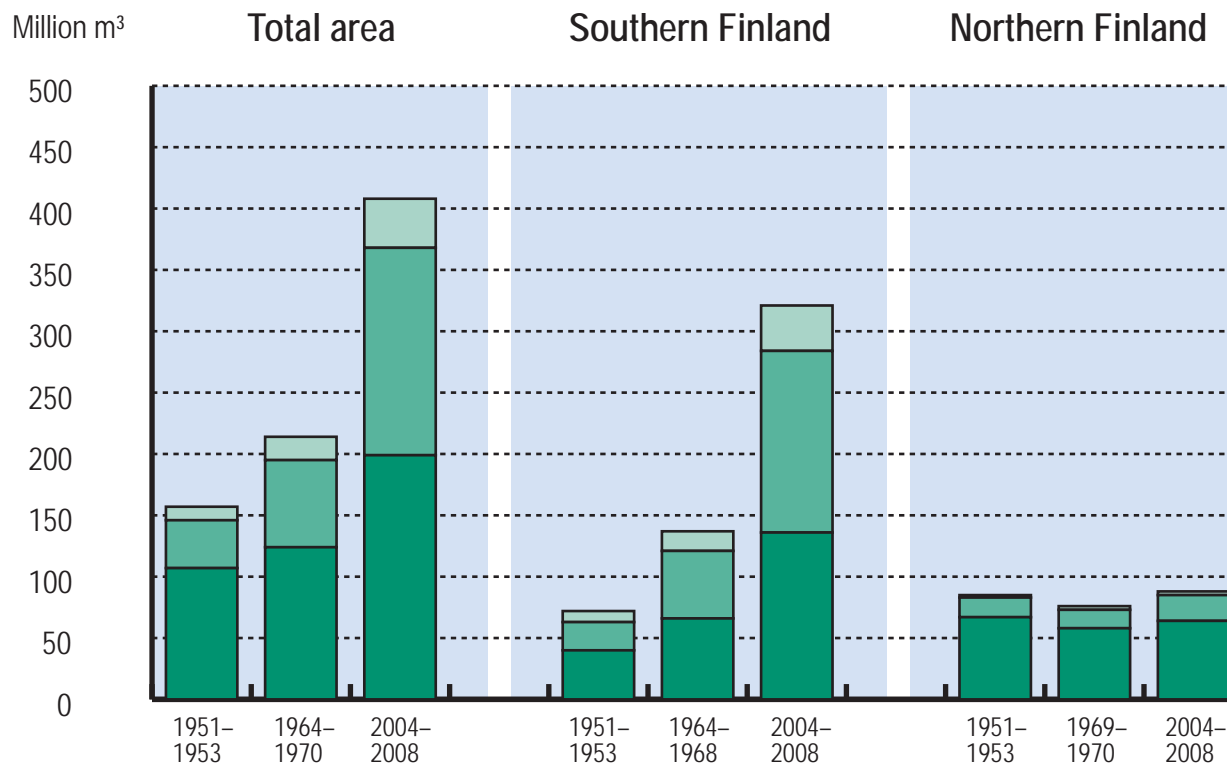


Amount of stout timber in 1951–2008



- Timber is considered stout when its diameter at a height of 130 centimetres is at least 30 centimetres.
- In Northern Finland, the average growth of forests is less than half of that in Southern Finland due to shorter growing season, colder climate and poorer soil.
