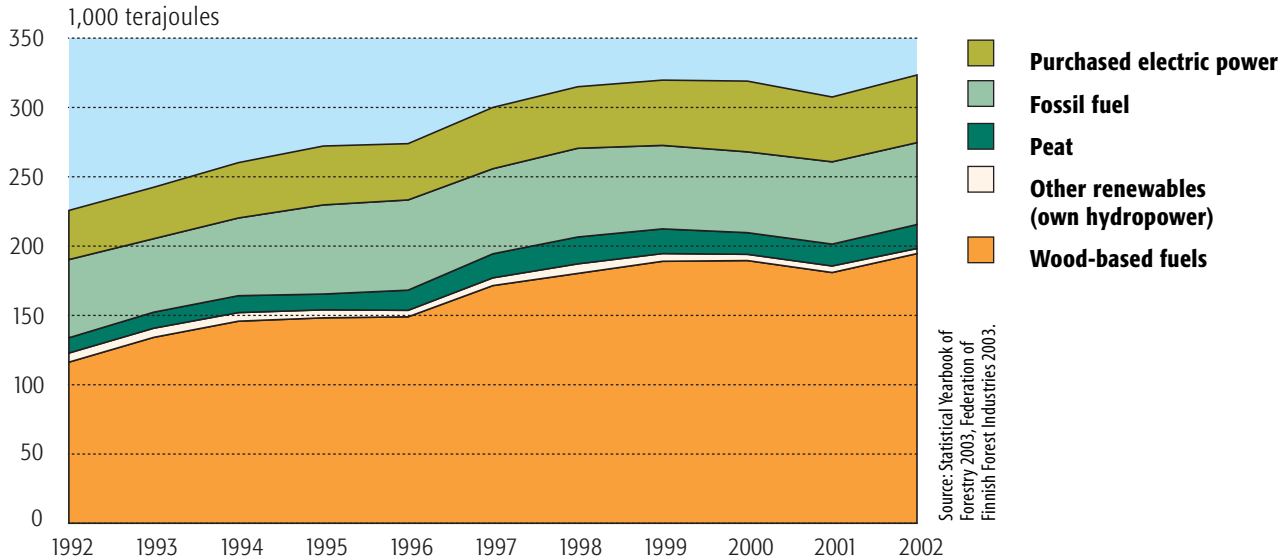


## Energy sources of forest industry in 1992–2002



- In 2002 the energy use of the forest industry included about 270,800 Tj of industrial fuel, most of which consisted of wood-based fuels. The fuels are used both in the production of electricity and heat and directly in industrial processes.
- The share of purchased electric power was about 49,000 terajoules. Most of this was generated in hydroelectric and nuclear plants, but due to technical details the exact share of each source cannot be given.
- The use of own hydroelectric power was 1030 GWh. It can't be converted accurately to terajoules because each source of energy has its own coefficient. Still, a good estimation is some 3,700 terajoules.
