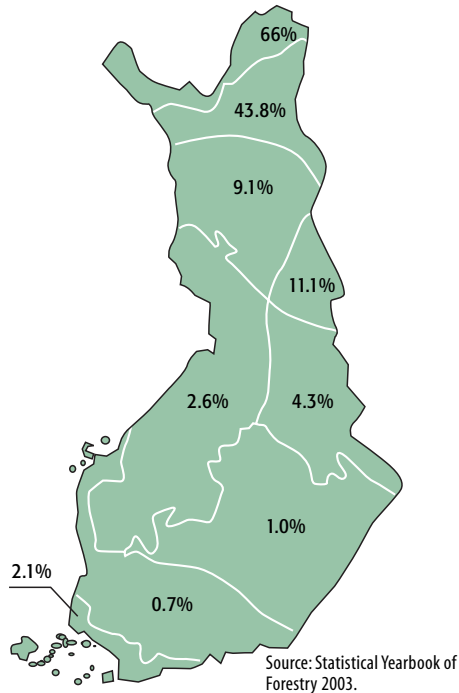
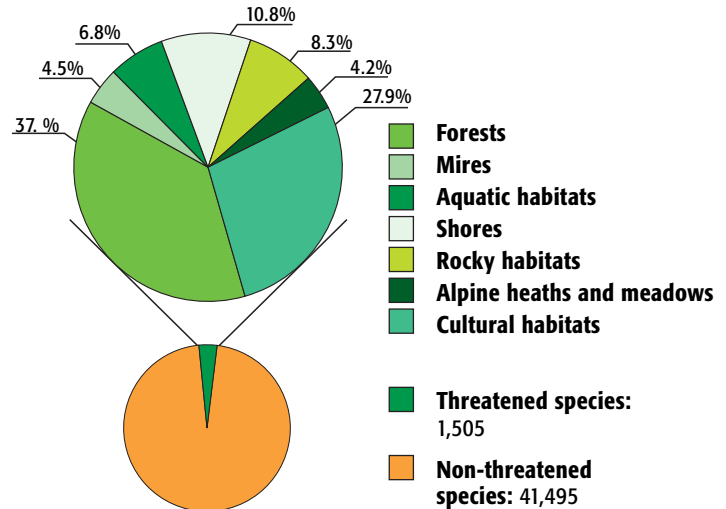


Level of strict forest protection by vegetation zone

- All in all there exist 43,000 known species in Finland. Threat for 19,000 species was evaluated and existing information was considered sufficient for 15,000 species.
- Forest management practices are considered as primary threat factor for 34.7 percent of threatened species. In the future they are considered as primary threat factor for 30.2 percent of threatened species.
