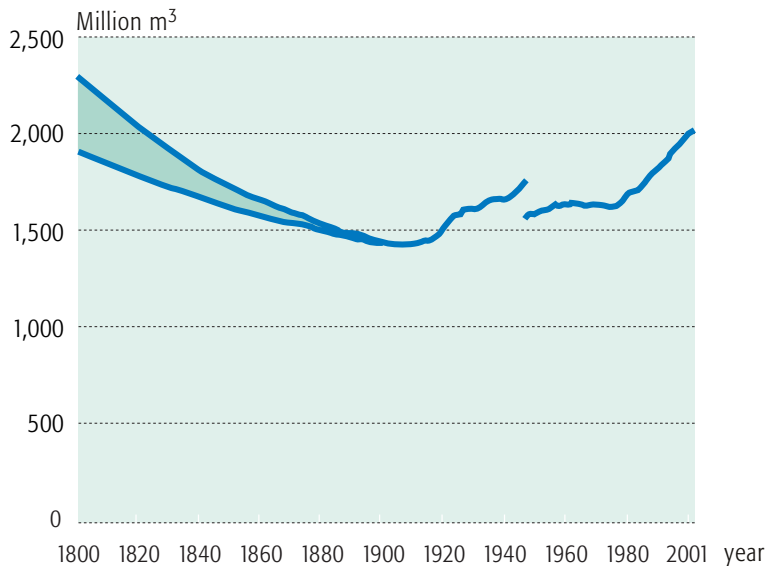


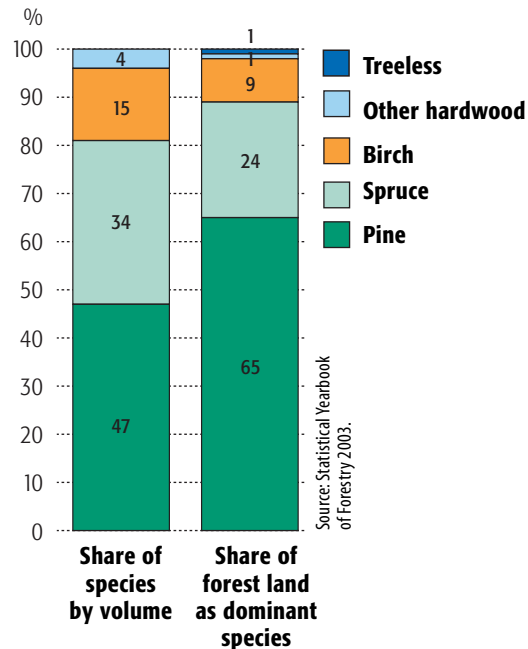
Development of the standing timber stock 1800–2001



- The discontinuity visible during the 1940s is due to the cession of land areas after World War II.
- Historical methods were used to assess the volumes of standing timber stock during the 19th century and the earlier part of the 20th century; thus, the more distant the period, the less reliable of the assessment.
