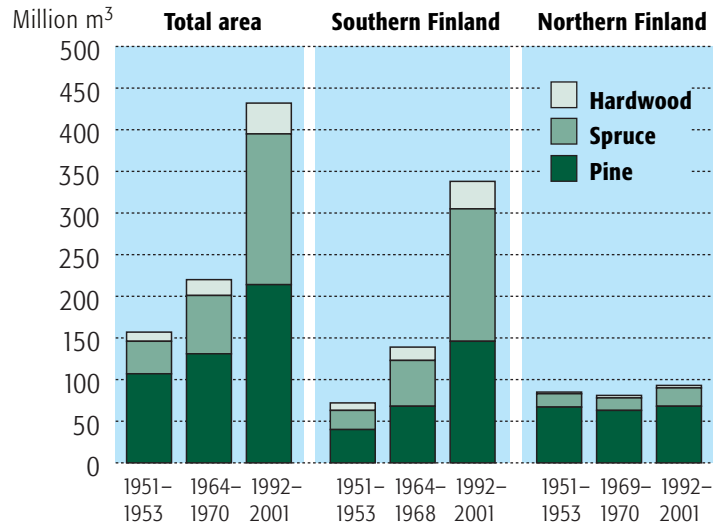


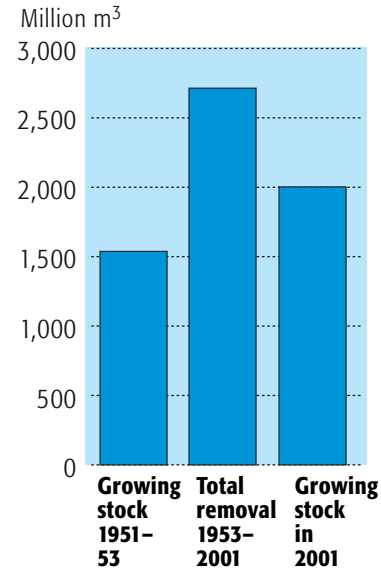
## Development of volume of stout timber in 1951–2001
